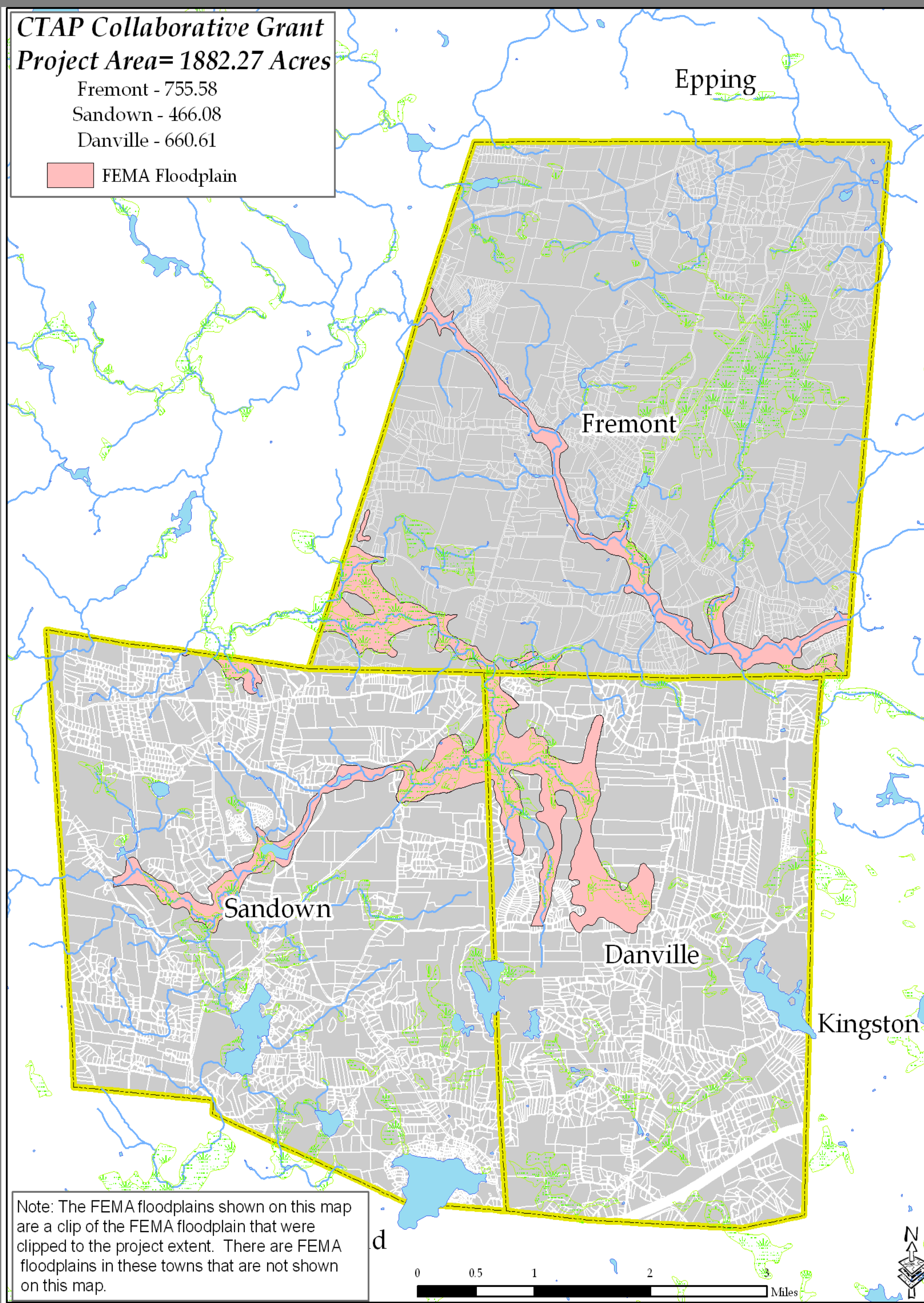
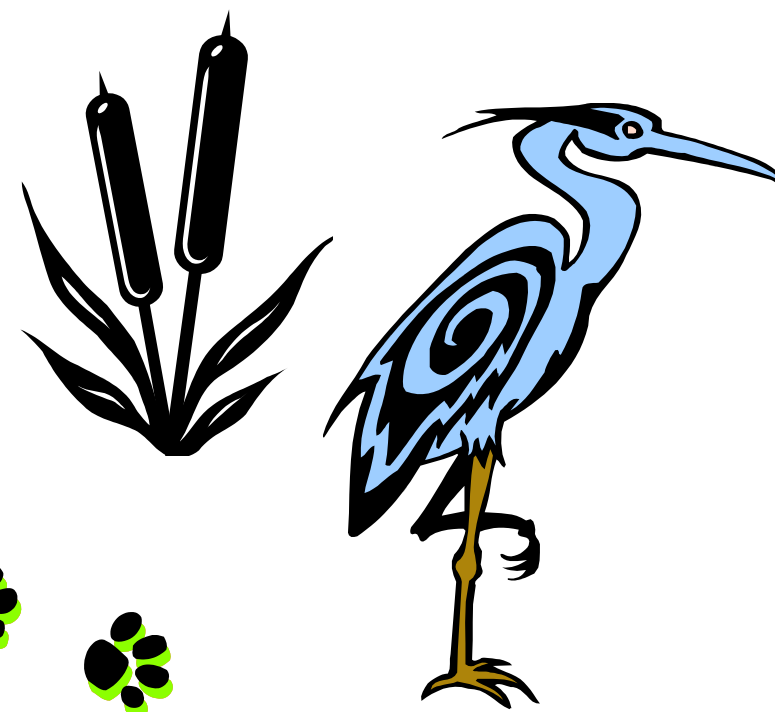


Exeter River Corridor Wildlife and Habitat Protection Project: Danville, Fremont and Sandown, New Hampshire

ACTIVITY #1

Complete a **bio-inventory** and report of wildlife, habitat, wetlands and other resources within selected areas of the Exeter River Corridor in Danville, Fremont, Sandown (refer to project area on map)

ACTIVITY 2

Develop **Master Plan** recommendations for Danville, Fremont, Sandown that addresses conservation of wildlife and habitat

ACTIVITY 3

Complete an **Open Space Plan** for the Town of Sandown

Implement an **education and outreach program** focusing on protection and preservation of wildlife and habitats in Danville, Fremont, and Sandown
